

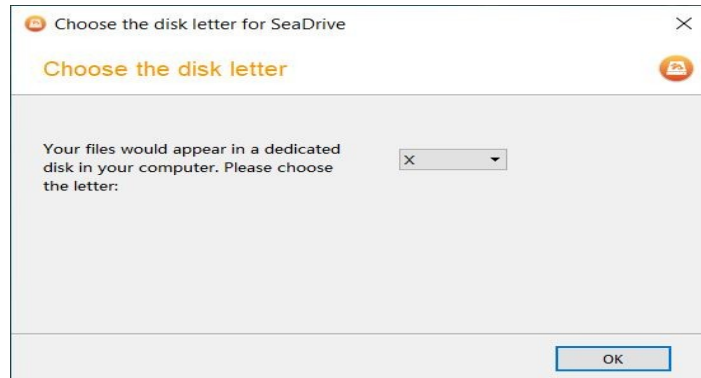
Instruction to map your Seafile-library as local drive on Windows

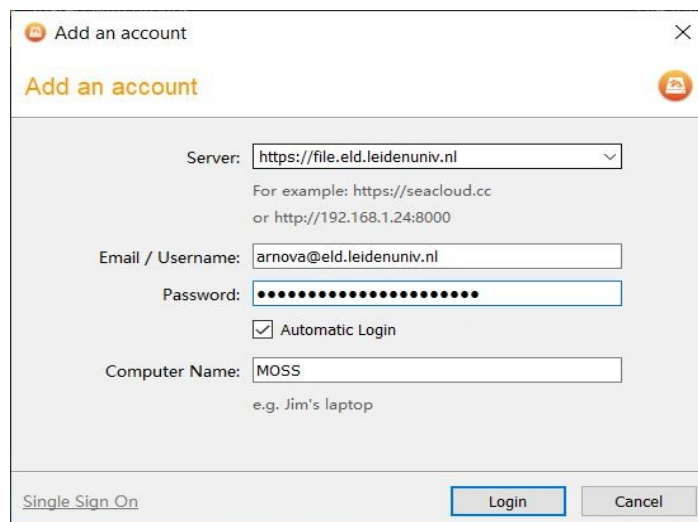
This instruction for Windows 10 will enable you to access your ELD Seafile-files from a local drive on your computer using the SeaDrive-client.

NOTE: Before you can proceed, your (home) IP address must be added to the ELD file server's firewall by me (Arno). When this is done you can install SeaDrive, available here: <https://www.eld.leidenuniv.nl/ftp/seadrive/>

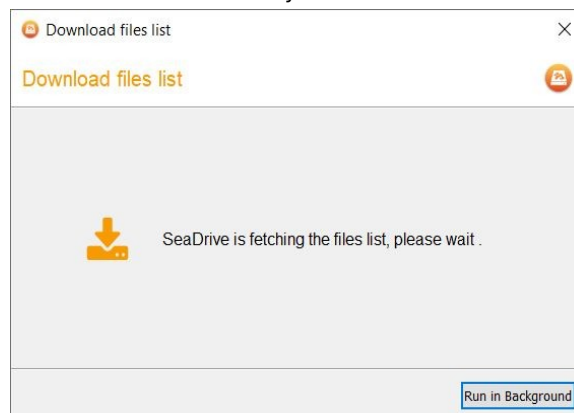
After you have finished the installation of SeaDrive, double-click the "SeaDrive" icon your desktop. Now the following dialog will appear:



You can optionally select another "disk-letter" (or accept the default) and click "OK". Next the account dialog-appears: enter the "Server:"-setting as displayed below. Furthermore input your Seafile-"Username" and your Seafile-password.



Now wait for SeaDrive to "Download files list". You can run this in the background, but note that your Seafile-files will be readonly until it is done:



Now all your Seafile-files("libraries") are available from the drive-letter you have selected during the installation :-)
